Parks Department Offers Learn-to-Sail Program

A pilot youth learn-to-sail program has been launched at Harbor Park Lake, Figueroa and L Streets, Wilmington, according to the Los Angeles City Recreation and Parks Department.

Sailing instructions will be given during the coming six weeks each Saturday at 9:30 and 11:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.

According to Michael C. Cronin, acting supervisor of aquatics for the department, classes started Feb. 23, and are open to youths 12 years of age and older. He added that enrollees must possess an American Red Cross Swimmer, Certificate or the equivalent, or be able to demonstrate adequate swimming skills.

The department plans to purchase five 8-foot boats for the sailing program with a \$1,000 gift received by the Recreation and Park Commission from an anonymous donor.

A department-owned 14-foot Super-Satellite class boat, and boats owned by Herman Hermanson, recreation director at Rosecrans Recreation Center, are currently being utilized in the pilot program.

Hermanson will conduct the classes, assisted by Dick Fletcher, senior aquatics director.
