The Red Sea Port of Jidda, Saudi Arabia, 30 miles from the Holy City of Mecca, will be the new home for Mr. and Mrs. Duane W. Busch of Torrance. Busch has been appointed manager of dining and commissary service for Saudi Arabian Airlines under a management assistance contract with Trans World Airlines. The arrangement provides for the loan of key TWA management personnel on an 18-month contract basis to assist Saudi Arabian Airlines in developing operational policies and procedures. TWA has a similar contract with Ethiopian Airlines.

BUSCH, 35, HAS been TWA's transportation manager of dining and commissary services at Los Angeles International Airport since 1960. He joined the airline in 1947. He leaves this week to begin his new duties in Saudi Arabia.
