Symphony Programs Classics

Two of the finest examples of classic musical tradition are programmed for the first concert of the 1963-64 season of

the Beach Cities Symphony, according to Jeanne Jefferson, orchestra manager.

Under the direction of Louis Palange, composer-conductor, the symphony will present Beethoven's "Eroic" and Robert Schumann's Concerto in A Minor tomorrow at 8:15, in the auditorium of Mira Costa High School in Manhattan Beach. Jane Courtland, concert pianist will perform the latter, accompanied by the 80-piece orchestra.

The symphony's four concerts each season are made possible by the joint sponsorship of the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors through the Music Commission and a grant from the Recording Industries Trust Fund of The American Federation of Musicians, Local 47, and by members and patrons of the Beach Cities Symphony Assn. A Narbonne High School graduate who received a doctorate in chemistry at UCLA last month has entered the

University of Otago in Dunedin, New Zealand, where he will pursue studies in the field of nonelectrolyte solutions on a postdoctoral fellowship for the next year.

Dr. Donald B. Myers, 27-year-old son of Mrs. Zanera Myers, 1535 W. 213th St., flew to Hawaii and on to New Zealand last week to begin his advanced studies with Dr. Arthur G. Williamson at the university. He is the son of the late Robert B. Myers, a Columbia Steel Co. employe for 20 years before his death 10 years ago.

DR. MYERS was graduated from Narbonne High School with the Class of '54 and entered UCLA where he received his bachelor of science degree in chemistry in 1958. While studying for his doctorate at the university, he was employed as a teaching assistant in physical chemistry and quantitative analysis courses. In his position he was in charge of student laboratories.

During summer months as an undergraduate, Dr. Myers worked for a major oil company as an analytical laboratory technician.

HIS DOCTOR'S thesis at UCLA was on the subject of thermodynamic functions of nonelectrolyte solutions, and was carried on under the direction of Professor Robert L. Scott.

While at UCLA, Dr. Myers was active in the mountaineers' organization.

Upon completion of his work at the University of Otago, Dr. Myers currently plans to pursue his studies in India. The HERALD was told.

Two sisters and two brothers live in Torrance. Living with their mother are brothers Richard and Robert and a sister, Marion. Another sister, Mrs. Lauralyn Mendenhall, lives nearby.
