
Spartans Attend LA Symposium

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE AMENDING APPENDIX I OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, 1954 (ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 791), RECLASSIFYING THAT CERTAIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN PLANNING COMMISSION CASE NO. 63-41.
WHEREAS, the City Council deems it to be in the public interest that certain changes in land use (zoning) classification be made in certain real property in the City of Torrance, California, hereinafter described in Section 3, (as applied for in Planning Commission Case No. 63-41);
WHEREAS, due and legal publication of notice has been given to the owners of property in the vicinity thereof and public hearings have been duly and regularly held, all as required by Appendix I of the Code of the City of Torrance, 1954;
NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Torrance does ordain as follows:
SECTION 1.
That the City Council of the City of Torrance does hereby find and determine that the Change of Zone applied for in Planning Commission Case No. 63-41, as more particularly described in Section 3 hereof, is necessary for the preservation and enjoyment of substantial property rights of the owners of property in the vicinity thereof; that said Change of Zone will not be materially detrimental to the public welfare or to the property in the vicinity thereof; that notice has been given, as required by Appendix I of the Code of the City of Torrance, 1954; that opportunity has been afforded to interested parties to be heard and to present the proposed Change of Zone before the Planning Commission and the City Council of the City of Torrance; and that hearings on the application have been held as therein provided.
SECTION 2.
