

Episcopalians Plan Watch By the Cross

Holy week at St. Andrew's Episcopal Church will continue today with celebration of Holy Communion at 6:30 and 11 a.m. and with the three-hour Watch By the Cross from noon until 3 p.m. tomorrow, Good Friday.

Observance of Holy Week at the church has been marked with morning prayer and intercessions for all members of the parish at 6:30 each morning during the week and the Wednesday evening Lenten service, under the leadership

of the Rev. Hugh R. Percy, rector.

Four Easter services have been scheduled at the church, 1432 Engracia Ave., for Sunday, beginning with the traditional sunrise service of Holy Communion at 5:30 a.m. Other celebrations of Easter will include celebration of Holy Communion at 7 a.m. and Choral Eucharist with Easter message at 9 and 11 a.m.

Area Choir Featured at Bowl Service

The 100-voice A Cappella Choir of Redondo Beach High School will be featured at the 43rd annual Hollywood Bowl Easter Sunrise Services this year. The choir will be under the direction of Thomas E. Wilson.

Soloists at the service will include Miss Peggy Coburn and John Raitt. Raitt will sing "The Lord's Prayer" and "Now Upon the First Day of the Week." Miss Coburn will sing "O Divine Redeemer."

The famous Sunrise Service will begin about 5:30 a.m. The Rev. Dr. Ralph W. Sockman, Minister Emeritus of Christ Church, Methodist, New York, will be guest speaker.

On Easter Sunday there will be a family service at 8 a.m. with the Junior Choir participating. At 9:30 a.m. the Youth Choir will sing and there will be church school classes and a nursery. At 11 a.m. the Chancel Choir will sing and again there will be church school classes and a nursery. The subject of the Rev. H. Milton Sippel's sermon at all three services will be: "Indestructible Life."
