TH-1500 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE ADDING SECTION 10-10.1 TO THE CITY CODE, PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF A CONDITIONAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT (C-5) AND ESTABLISHING THE SAME.
The City Council of the City of Torrance does hereby ordain as follows:
SECTION 1. That Section 10-10.1 is hereby added to the City Code, Ordinance (Appendix I) of "The Code of the City of Torrance, 1954" to read in whole as follows:

SECTION 2. The following restrictions shall apply to all property in Zone C-5:
A. Permissible Uses:
1. Any building, structure or improvement shall be erected, constructed, established, altered or enlarged hereunder to be used for residential purposes, except hotels and motels, and accessory structures existing hereunder February 1, 1962, have been removed; provided, however, that a dwelling house may be altered or enlarged if such alteration or enlargement does not increase the occupancy thereof.
2. A variance or use permit shall not be granted to permit the conversion for commercial use or occupancy of any building, structure or improvement which is designed, arranged or intended to be occupied or used for residential purposes.
