County pet owners may have their pets vaccinated against rabies on a cost basis from July 9 to July 30. The rabies inoculation program will be coordinated by county poundmaster Marvin T. Thorndson in cooperation with local community service clubs. Cost of the injection is \$1.50 per animal. All cities require evidence of a rabies vaccination before issuing a license.
