Home-coming will be a dramatic experience for the slight 14-year-old youngster who came to America several weeks ago with a serious congenital cleft palate condition that deformed his facial features but who returns to the little backward mountain village in Sonora a handsome boy with a normal face.

THE MIRACLE that transformed Anselmo from an ugly duckling into a striking young man is the work of the medical missionary section of Century City Doctor's Foundation, non-profit charitable organization that operates Beverly Hills Doctor's Hospital of 10390 Santa Monica Blvd., where the operations on young Chavez occurred.

The medical missionary section is composed of doctors who are airplane pilots. As a charity project these physicians fly into small towns in Mexico which are devoid of medicines and medical care and set up emergency clinics to heal the sick and injured without charge.

ANSELMO was flown home Friday by Jack R. Magit, M.D., director of the non-profit Beverly Hills Doctor's Hospital and a member of the group of flying physicians, in the medical-missionary section's new plane, a twin-engine six-place Piper Aztec. Among those on the plane trip were Dr. Bert Sabo, a dentist and pilot, who first saw Anselmo in Mexico and brought his plight to the attention of the flying doctors. Dr. Sabo, of Montclair, had gone to Mesa de Jalindo to pick up a stolen private plane that had been crash landed near the village.

The plane landed on a field about an hour's hike over rugged terrain from Anselmo's home village, which is quite unaccessible.

IT TOOK two major operations, considerable dental work and minor cosmetic follow-up techniques to bring about the medical miracle on Anselmo. The first operation closed the cleft palate and the second closed the gaps on his upper lip and nose. Prior to the operation Anselmo had difficulty speaking with his voice sounding like a hiss. Now, he can make normal sounds and with speech therapy is learning to talk like everyone else.
