Personal preferences for comedians differ as widely (and often as wildly) as preferences for mates. Just as many people wonder what their best friends see in their wives as what they see in their favorite comedians. My choice is Jonathan Winters.

Winters popped up on television so suddenly that most of us figured he had been around for a long while and we somehow had missed him. He hadn't. It happened just ten years ago on "Talent Scouts"—his first big break.

After that he appeared on all those shows that live almost entirely for guests who can perform—Garry Moore, Steve Allen, Dave Garroway, Masquerade Party, and the Paar Show where he made his biggest public impression.

HE WAS born in Dayton, Ohio, 38 years ago. He joined the Marine Corps when he was 17. After his discharge he worked at a variety of jobs ending up as a disc jockey on Dayton's WING. His failure at that prompted him to try Talent Scouts as a comedian. With the exception of two brief interludes—one with the bottle, the other with a breakdown—his success as a comedian has been continuous.

Winters is known as a man who is always "on," but I have been with him when he is "off," relaxed and ungrinning. Sometimes it doesn't last long because of the man's enormously inventive mind. He is crazy for ows—live ones and those that are made of

wood, paper, painted, or what-have-you. Then in the middle of a serious discussion on owls, he'll suddenly break into a hilarious imitation of an Audubon Society chairman addressing a bird-watchers' club.

MY FAMILY life means more to me than anything else and I would do anything to keep it happy," he told me. "I gave up the night club circuit long ago to be able to work closer to home." He met his wife at the Dayton Art Institute and they have two children.

Recently Winters told the UPI some interesting things about comedy and comedians.

"I've always maintained that people can make you LOOK funny. Paint your nose red, put little dots on your face and the audience will laugh. But people cannot make you funny. You've got to think funny. You don't think funny all the time. If I did I'd be a complete ass."

AFTER STEALING the movie "It's a Mad, Mad, Mad, Mad World" from a brace of more famous comedians (including Ethel Merman) his future in films is now assured. His future in television always has been. He has signed with NBC for as many specials as he cares to do this year and next, or a weekly series if he wishes.

Although he wears better than any other comedian on television—due to his versatility—I hope he takes it easy. With comedians, as with almost everything else in show business, absence makes the heart grow fonder.

Law in Action

Today many clubs and "non-profit" groups are big enterprises. They own property, handle money, and do many business-like things. For this reason such clubs and many social groups come under various government regulations.

The Attorney General, for example, enforces the laws dealing with charitable organizations. They must submit yearly financial reports to him and yearly information returns to the Internal Revenue Service. These reports are subject to audit and failure to account properly for funds can mean the charity's loss of tax exempt status.

THE OTHER day one group began organizing a country club for golfing, swimming, tennis, etc. These organizers paid a fixed fee for their membership. Others could join later if the club members approved. They might have to pay more to join if the club facilities increased. Members could sell their membership but only with club approval.

Such memberships were "securities," said the California Supreme Court. Just like the seller of stocks and bonds, the club had to register with the Corporations Commissioner,

get state approval, and submit to regulation of its sale of memberships.

FUND RAISING, if not properly done, can run afoul of the law. Sales of chances on prizes can break the lottery laws. Improper solicitation can break local laws. Even the hot dog and soft drink concessions at Little League baseball games must file sales tax returns.

Many groups have recently incorporated to limit the liability of officers and members. A club owning or leasing property, or hiring employees may be sued for the negligence of its agents or employees. The members may find themselves personally liable to the person injured. Incorporation makes only the club liable, as a rule.

INCORPORATION also makes it necessary to comply with corporation rules and to meet tax regulations. But on the other hand, incorporation can also give tax benefits to non-profit organizations.
