## Film Tells Story of Adoptions

Community leaders and representatives of agencies concerned with child welfare have been invited to attend the premier showing of a new adoption film in the Board of Supervisors hearing room tonight.

The film, "Angel by the Hand," will be shown for the first time at 8 p.m., according to Supervisor Ernest E. Debs. The film depicts the story of the Los Angeles County Bureau of Adoptions and is being presented to familiarize people with adoption proceedings.

More than 1,600 children were placed by the bureau last year, said Debs. All 1,600 were under two months of age. The bureau still has difficulty

placing children of minority races, said Debs.

The film was made by Don Hoster and is narrated by Marvin Miller. Robert Hecker prepared the script. Persons in-

## Harvey Grants Plant Contract

Complete control systems for Harvey Aluminum's new plant in St. Croix, U. S. Virgin Islands, will be supplied by Fischer and Porter under a contract exceeding three-quarter million dollars, the instrument

and controls manufacturer has announced.

Now under construction, the plant will process bauxite into alumina for shipment to Harvey's primary aluminum reduction facilities.

## Plans Approved For Tract Roads

Final plans and specifications for new streets in a tract located near Hawthorne Avenue and Silver Spur Road have been approved by the County

Road Department. The developer will spend about \$153,000 for access streets to 94 homesites in the tract.
