Psychologist to Give Lecture

Arthur L. Bietz, Ph. D., prominent Los Angeles psychologist, will give the ninth in a series of ten health lectures at the Hawthorne Masonic Temple, Broadway at Grevillea streets, November 30, at 7:30 p.m.

Dr. Bietz, consulting psychologist at White Memorial Hospital, will speak on "How To Achieve Emotional Maturity."

An author as well as educator and lecturer, Dr. Bietz has written three books for young people: "Conquering Personal Problems, Guideposts to Happiness, and In Quest of Life."

He recently returned from an extensive lecture tour, speaking to dozens of county-wide teachers' institutes in California, Oregon, and Washington. Dr. Bietz is professor of Applied Christianity at the College of Medical Evangelists, Los Angeles.

A former member of the board of directors of the Los Angeles is affiliated with the American Psychological Association.

He will lecture here under the auspices of the Hawthorne Seventh-day Adventist Church which is sponsoring the health series as a free public service to residents in the community.
