

Local Talent Featured in 'Our Town' August 1, 2.

Thornton Wilders' Pulitzer prize winning play, "Our Town," will soon make its local debut on August 1 and 2 in the Torrance high school auditorium featuring outstanding talent from the Torrance community and neighboring cities.

The centrally staged production, the first of its kind in Torrance, will have among its personnel such well known local names as Duane Ryan, who is remembered for his recent portrayal of Senator Rawkins in "Finian's Rainbow" for El Camino College. Other local plays that have featured Duane in leading roles have been "The Late Christopher Bean," "King John," "Of Thee I Sing," "The Winslow Boy," and "The Silver Cord." In "Our Town" Duane is faced with perhaps his biggest challenge to date playing the part of the "Stage Manager" which was made famous by the late Frank Craven on Broadway. After completing his season with the Torrance Community Players, Duane plans to enter U.C.L.A. to prepare for a lawyer's career. But he hopes to continue his love of theatre by taking part in productions on the Bruin campus.

The First Baptist Church of Torrance announces that Dr. Karl G. Sabiers, author, world traveler, and publisher will be the morning speaker on July 13th.


Dr. Sabiers is president of the Robertson Publishing Company in Glendale.


X-ray Unit Here Soon
