signal both at this intersection and at Prairie, and stated that the two have high priority among traffic projects.

With Crenshaw Blvd. officially trafficable now all the way through to Highway 101, much more traffic is expected and better traffic regulations will be needed.

The installation of the signal is a joint Torrance-county project, with each paying half the cost. The county recently approved a plan for such a signal submitted by Torrance.

ray may show abnormalities of the chest such as tumors or enlarged hearts as well as tuberculosis. Anyone over 15 years of age may obtain a chest x-ray. However, children between the ages of 15 and 18 should be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Local organizations represented by the Citizens Advisory Committee of the Torrance Health District, will assist in the Mobile Chest X-Ray Survey.
