

### 'Lights Not Trick But Treat ...'

"When the representative for street lights calls on homeowners of the Torrance Gardens and Plaza tracts it will be a treat for you ... not a trick," David R. Cooper of the Homeowners association declared this week. "Remember ... street lights protect your children at night, prevent accidents, improve the appearance of your community, and increase the value of your property," Cooper stated. "If short on cash, you may make arrangements with the Torrance National Bank. Only one trip is necessary."

### SURVEY MAY RESULT IN MORE FUNDS

School officials are completing surveys here to determine the number of persons moving into Torrance during the past two years to work in Federal Defense industries. Results of such a survey may qualify the district for federal funds under the provisions of Public Laws 815 and 874. Created by the government to help districts which have felt a heavy influx of students because families have moved into the area as the result of defense production, the two laws provide for federal assistance in building new schools and in the operation of the schools.

Public Law 815 provides for funds to expand plants and for the construction of new schools, while Public Law 874 provides funds to help the district pay for the costs of maintenance and operation.

School Superintendent J. H. Hull said that more than \$60,000 in federal funds may be obtained by the district from the latter law.

The district has already received \$964,000 under the provision of Public Law 815 for new construction and has received entitlement for additional funds. However, no additional funds have been appropriated by Congress.
