Out of four entries made by the Ben Cluff Dairy, each of the four was awarded a gold medal (first prize). The four samples consisted of Grade A pasteurized milk, homogenized milk, whipping cream, and half-and-half. They were awarded top honors on the basis of low bacteria count, flavor, odor, and butterfat content. Prizes were given according to points earned.




