Joseph Piatt Resigns From Moose Post

The Torrance Moose lodge this week voted to accept the resignation of Joseph Piatt as governor of the local fraternity, and immediately set Monday, January 17, as the date on which a new governor will be elected to fill Piatt's unexpired term of office.

The former Moose governor gave "a change of working shifts at his place of employment" as his reason for submitting his resignation with regrets. Piatt completed eight months of his year term of office, following Dan Desmond as governor in April of 1954. He had previously served as vice-president of the California Moose association.

Nominees
Marvin McArthur, Dan Hutchinson and Stanley Helman have been placed in nomination for election to the unexpired term of the governor's office, according to an announcement by the Nominating committee.

McArthur is a past junior governor and governor of the lodge. Hutchinson has held the offices of treasurer and club steward, while Helman has served as a junior governor.

A vacancy in the office of lodge prelate will also be filled in the election on January 17. Carl Fisher, junior governor, is acting governor of the Torrance lodge in the interim.
