As of January 1, 1955, the clinic numbered 77 completed cases, including 180 extractions, 334 base fillings, 36 specials, 70 cleanings, and 106 x-rays. It was reported, a total of \$3574 has been made available for dental work to date.

The program is set up for children of kindergarten age through high school in the Torrance Unified School District. Children unable to afford the services of a dentist are eligible for this program. Moderate fees are charged. The work is done in the dentist's own office, using his materials, office help, and facilities.

Thirteen dentists are presently participating in the program and 23 Torrance organizations are contributing. The clinic is set up not only for emergency work but for complete dental work when needed and when it cannot be financed privately.

If a winner has purchased a new Chevrolet during the contest, he will be presented with the full retail price of a 1955


Harell Maloy In Maneuvers
