by the parking committee headed by C. T. Rippey.

The report proposed the acquisition of 15 lots which would provide 310 parking spaces. At least 250 meters should be installed on these lots, it was pointed out.

The cost of these sites is to be born by downtown property owners only. Proposed is a \$200,000 bond issue to be paid off over a period of 20 years.

A total of 60 per cent of the income from parking meters would go to pay for the off-street parking lots. Cost to the downtown property owners would be \$268.50 per \$1000 assessed valuation. Average annual payment per \$1000 assessed valuation was figured at \$13.07 with the first annual payment being \$15.93.

No final decision has been made as to what lots are to be purchased but a number of possible sites have been proposed.

### Lomita Schools To Be Improved If Bonds Voted

Harbor and South area junior and senior high school facilities, facing an unprecedented enrollment deluge, will be considerably enlarged to meet this challenge if Los Angeles citizens approve school bond Propositions 1, 2, and 3 on the April 5 ballot.

Proposed extensive facilities for existing plants, plus the erection of new schools, was revealed today in a breakdown of the high school portion of the

\$133,000,000 bond issue being submitted to the voters next month.

Mrs. John Monaghan of the WALTERIA P.T.A. announced that \$708 was collected for the recent March of Dimes in the vicinity.

Included are the completion of the new Narbonne high school including classrooms and physical education facilities for 2000 pupils and the following additions to the present Narbonne high school: instrumental music unit; lighting and acoustics in old shop, main and classroom buildings; counselor and health unit; and converting senior classrooms for junior high.
