


South Bay Shopping Center To Have Largest Ralphs Market



The largest Ralphs supermarket ever built will be one of the outstanding features of South Bay Shopping Center located at 174th street and Hawthorne boulevard. According to Robert H. Adler, general manager of Brody Investment company, developers of the vast shopping center, architectural plans for Ralphs have been completed.

The building will be in excess of 39,000 square feet, and will cost more than \$460,000 plus over \$175,000 in merchandising fixtures. Of contrasting red brick and gleaming white plaster, the building features a covered concourse making it possible to move to and from it and any other building in the development without being exposed to the elements.

Parking Feature
Magic Carpet doors will provide convenient access from the north, south, and east. Parking stalls in the vicinity of the market will be six inches further apart than normal so that shoppers with large packages will have an easy time putting them in their automobiles.

Other features will be the first Ralphs snack bar; twenty-two foot high windows on

the north wall and a full length, 150 foot long mirror over the produce stalls on the south wall. Meat will be cut and prepackaged on the premises on a 50 foot refrigerated conveyor.

Sidney F. Brody, president of Brody Investment Company, said bids have been called for and construction on the multi-million dollar Bowlero recreation center should begin prior to September 1.

Walter N. Marks is the leasing agent on the 55 acre project. Leasing representative in the South Bay area is E. J. Champion of Redondo Beach.


