Temple PTA Plans Dance



First Lutheran Church Sets Evangelism Area Mission

Members and friends of First Lutheran church, Carson and Flower, are making extensive plans for participation in the Lutheran Evangelism area mission, which is to take place October 30 to November 4.

According to Rev. Paul Wenske, pastor of the church, there will be about 125 other Lutheran churches of National Lutheran council carrying on this program at that time.

This area mission stresses the three-fold emphasis of preaching, teaching and reaching. A guest missionary will speak at First Lutheran church every evening from Sunday through Thursday at 8 p.m. Special music will be a feature of the preaching mission.

VISITING TEAMS

During the week preceding the mission, every member and home of First Lutheran church will be visited by teams of visitors. All of the members will be asked to support the mission and to manifest loyalty to Christ and His church. Each family will be urged to conduct a daily Bible and prayer period

known as the Family Altar.

In preparation for the Mission Week cottage prayer meetings are held in various areas in the homes of the members.

Immediately preceding the Mission there will be a 24-hour prayer vigil at the church.

During mission week teams of visitors from First Lutheran church will call on unchurched people in this area. These visitors will tell what Christ and His church mean to them.

They will bring a friendly invitation and will encourage those outside the church to enroll in the pastor's adult classes, to have their children baptized and to enroll them in the Sunday school.

This is not only a one-week

program, but part of a year-round emphasis.

LAY SCHOOL

In addition to these features of the mission, a lay school on evangelism will be held on Sunday afternoon, October 30, from 5:15 in Our Savior's Lutheran church, Long Beach.




