Charges given by Thomas H. Block of Torrance Sand and Gravel following a conversation with a reporter from the Torrance Press, are as follows:

Homeowners: Trucks are traveling to the sand and gravel operation between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. in violation of one of the conditions.

Block: Our firm does not open before 6 a.m. We can't stop trucks from coming up here earlier than that. But we do not service them.

Homeowners: The operation is not being sprayed with water to lessen dust conditions.

Block: This is a misapprehension. We have a man on a water truck continuously all day long. He makes four trips.

Homeowners: The firm was to plant ground cover within 30 days after the variance was granted. This has not been done.

Block: They have a bit of a

legitimate complaint. We went on the assumption that only the 50 acres of the variance were affected by this condition. But on checking, we find that the area down to Tandem Way is included. We are making plans to comply with this condition now.

Homeowners: The firm was to plant foliage and large trees in addition to those already planted within 30 days.

Block: The trees have all been planted and inspected. They are from 8-10 ft. tall.

Homeowners: The most flagrant violation is that the firm has been operating on Sundays for the last two weeks.

Block: We never work on Sundays except during an emergency. We worked last Sunday because we are supplying material for the Harbor Freeway. They needed the material because they were afraid that an anticipated rain would wash out the job. The Sunday previous to that we had to bail the sump—this must be done once every 6-8 weeks.
