Four of the nation's foremost engineering societies have honored Donald W. Douglas for advancing the art of transportation through development and production of the "DC" series of airplanes.


Douglas, founder and president of the Douglas Aircraft company, was chosen to receive the 1956 Elmer A. Sperry Award.


