Groundbreaking ceremonies were held Monday for Windsor Florists who will locate in the McNeil building going up at the corner of Torrance blvd. and Crenshaw.
Bob and Ike Collins, brothers and partners, stated that this will be the third Windsor Florists, the other two being located at 4903 W. Slauson and

1032 S. Pacific Coast hwy., in Redondo Beach.
Bob Collins, who was literally born in a flower shop in Long Beach, stated that the Torrance shop is expected to open before Easter. It will be an open air flower market, like the other stores.
"A house with flowers is a home," Collins stated, indicating that it is their aim to make flowers available at a reasonable rate to local families.
Two more stores are being planned in this area during the next year, and the brothers are presently signing a lease on another flower shop in Torrance.
The family owns seven flower shops all over Southern California.
