'RIG-A-BACK'

"Rig-a-back" method of transporting drilling rigs is demonstrated at Houston, Texas, prior to use by the Australasian Petroleum Co., in jungle areas of Papua, on the island of New Guinea. Two National type 50 rigs, made by the National Supply Co., have been sectionalized into loads not exceeding 4000 pounds each so they can be carried quickly by helicopter to drilling locations where there are few, if any, roads.

Councilman Nick Draie voting against it. Approval is subject to four conditions recommended by the Planning Commission.
