The 523rd Air Force band from March Air Force base will play in cooperation with the showing of "Battle Hymn" at the Grand Theatre in observance of Torrance's "Salute to the Air Force" commemorating fifty years of Air Power.

"Battle Hymn" is the story of the life of Col. Dean Hess, a minister who left the pulpit to return to the Air Force in Korea. In addition to training the ROK Air Force and flying 250 missions in ground support.

### Place Dentures Immediately After Extraction

"What is an immediate denture?"—asks Mrs. L. R. of Harbor City.

An immediate denture is one where the remaining natural teeth are removed and the denture is placed directly in the mouth, so the patient does not have to go without teeth.

Usually the front teeth are left. Then when the denture is ready, these are extracted and the denture inserted.

As the gums heal, the denture will gradually loosen up and sore spots may develop as the denture continues to settle. If the denture becomes too loose, your dentist may recommend some form of adhesive to help you until the gums are completely healed.

The denture can then be refitted, or in cases where the change is so great that the bite has changed, the dentures may have to be remade.
