

## Hearing Tuesday On New Building Height Districts

The establishment of building height districts within the Torrance Shoestring Strip and Harbor Area will be the subject of a public hearing to be conducted by the City Planning Commission on Tuesday, February 18, at 2:15.

The hearing will be held in the hearing room of the Wilmington Branch City Hall located at 411 Neptune avenue, Wilmington. Also to be considered are minor adjustments in the existing boundaries of various zones to bring them into close conformance with present ownership and lot lines.

The following communities are included within this area: Torrance, Wilmington, San Pedro and a portion of Gardena.

In summary, the staff recommendation would keep the predominate portion of the area in the most restrictive height zone; namely, Height District No. 1. This permits heights limited only by the requirement that the total floor area within the structure may not exceed three times the buildable area of the lot except in the R1, R2 and R3 Zones, where the height is definitely limited to three stories.

The first sound-on-film talking pictures, consisting of vaudeville shorts, were shown in New York City in 1926 by Lee De Forest.


