Associate in arts degrees will be awarded to more than 400 graduates of El Camino College tomorrow afternoon at 4 o'clock in commencement exercises to be conducted in the college stadium.
Speaker for the commencement program will be Dr. Henry Cord Meyer, professor of history at Pomona College. The public is invited to attend the exercises. Dr. Forrest G. Murdock, president, said today.
Degrees will be presented to the college graduates by Seymour Taylor, president of the college board of trustees. Music for the program will be provided by the college band.
Dr. Meyer, who completed work for his bachelor of arts degree at the University of Colorado, obtained his master of arts at the University of Iowa and his Ph.D. at Yale University. During the war years of 1941-45 he served as research analyst with the Office of Strategic Services. The commencement speaker, whose topic will be "Your Individual Tomorrow," has served as a visiting professor at the University of Heidelberg, the University of Wisconsin, and Stanford University.
Dr. Meyer was awarded the George Louis Beer Prize of the American Historical Association in 1956 for his "Mitteleuropa in German Thought and Action 1815-1945."


