Local Area Lutheran Leaders Aid In Hospital Fund Drive

Organizing support of Lutherans in the southwest area for the \$3,000,000 California Hospital Forward Fund are Rev. Maynard V. Midthun of Torrance, pastor of Christ the King Lutheran Church, and Lloyd H. Thornblad, Servomechanisms executive.

"While we have our own community hospitals in this section, California Hospital is a specialty institution that annually cares for 563 patients residing in this vicinity," the Lutheran leaders said.

They emphasized that, since 1887, the California Hospital has cared for all patients regardless of color, creed, or circumstance. In 1957 the cost of charitable care and education programs totaled \$445,666.

The need for more beds and space required to install the latest scientific developments in the medical field have necessitated the major expansion and modernization program of the non profit hospital at 1414 S. Hope.

The California Hospital's southwest committee, led by Pastor Midthun and Mr. Thornblad, met recently at George's Chicken House to plan an early fall fund-up of the local drive.

Religious School Opens Saturday
