The Indianapolis drivers and their powerful Offenhauser mid-gets will make their local 1959 debut Feb. 15, when J. C. Agajanian presents a 100-lap USAC National Championship midget auto race at new Ascot Stadium, 183rd and Vermont Avenue.

A tremendous battle between George Amick, who finished second at Indianapolis in 1958, and Tony Bettenhausen, who took fourth in the 1958 "500," had the fans up on their feet yelling during the 50-mile feature that closed out the 1958 season on the fast half-mile dirt oval at Ascot Stadium.

Many racing officials called this final race of 1958, which settled both the USAC national and Pacific Coast midget championships, one of the five most thrilling midget races ever held locally.


