Many people wonder where the license money the Department of Fish and Game collects is being used. A good example is the research now being done on Big Bear Lake.

One-hundred largemouth bass averaging one pound in weight have just been put in Big Bear as brood fish. They are expected to spawn in June and July. Why are they again being introduced after it was found that there wasn't enough natural food to support all the bass and trout and crappie in the lake?

The Department of Fish and Game has just imported four million freshwater smelt eggs from Japan. They are expected to provide a good source of natural food for the fish.

The smelt feed largely on microscopic food organisms not generally utilized by adult trout and bass so they are not expected to compete with the game fish for food. It has been proven that all game fish grow faster in lakes where small forage fish are present. These smelt rarely exceed three inches.

If these fish do survive the results could be as good as the results when threadfin shad were introduced in Lake Mohave and the Colorado River.

The bass and crappie grow faster and larger than ever before and the waters could support more fish and thus provided better fishing for more people. This is one of the aims of our Fish and Game and as I have said before they sure are trying.
