Successful Ground Launching of Ryan Firebees Announced

PLAN SHOPPING CENTER
Kegley, Westphal, Arbogast and Stewart, Los Angeles architectural firm in Hollywood, with headquarters at 800 S. Robertson Blvd., has been named to design the structures for a 125-acre Holidayland to be located in San Pedro, according to James B. Stewart, AIA.

Successful ground launchings of Ryan Firebees at the Army's White Sands Missile Range, New Mexico, disclosed today, have given these jet-fast free-flying target missiles a new operational potential—surveillance and reconnaissance with the Army's ground troops.

The White Sands tests, in which Firebees are literally shot into the air from the ground, also provide the jet targets with greater flexibility as realistic "enemy" targets for ground-to-air and air-to-air missiles, by freeing them from aircraft launching in regions lacking air strips and during periods of bad weather.

Now, ground launching will enable the Army to conduct its own air defense maneuvers and evaluation of its ground-to-air missiles without dependence on aircraft support from other services. The Firebee target system also is given greater mobility, permitting its use in almost all types of terrain and remote training areas.

In addition to its basic function as a weapon systems target, the Firebee offers new tactical potential to the Army—as a reconnaissance and surveillance vehicle which could transmit vital information about enemy positions by photographic or electronic means.
