Aliens Must File Address Report
 The United States Immigration and Naturalization Service reminded aliens in Southern California today that 17 days remain in which non-citizens must file their annual address report as required by law. George K. Rosenberg, district director, pointed out that address report forms are available at all Immigration Service offices and post office for the convenience of aliens who are required to report their address to the government each January under a provision of the Immigration and Nationality Act of 1952. Rosenberg stated: "I urge all persons subject to this law to go to the nearest Immigration Office or post office and fill out an address report form before Jan. 31 deadline to avoid possible serious penalties." The immigration official said that approximately 220,000 aliens in Southern California filed reports during the first two weeks of the January reporting period.
