To determine the winner, a board of one officer and four enlisted men interviewed the selected candidates, checking their knowledge of current events, military conduct and procedures and job skills.

After interviewing all candidates, Specialist Bailey, battery clerk and qualified Nike missileman, was selected as the Soldier of the Month.


