

Easter Week Schedule to Start April 9
The Rev. Gilbert Zimmerman, chairman of the YMCA camp committee, revealed Easter camping schedules today.
A junior Olympics for boys six and older will start the week Saturday, April 9. They will compete in 12 track and field events.
Older teenagers also will depart April 9 for a rugged back-pack hike in the San Jacinto mountains. They will travel more than 40 cross-country miles from pine to palms on their own steams.
Boys nine to 12 and their fathers will visit Santa Barbara, Lake Cachuma, Solvang, and other points. They will camp on the beach and spend part of their holiday fishing, swimming, and shell collecting. They also will depart April 9.
Boys 12 and older may take a Catalina carvan from April 11 through April 14. Traveling to Emerald Cove on a fishing boat, the boys will set up camp on this isolated Catalina beach. Their time will be spent in hiking, swimming, water skiing, and sight seeing.
Girls eight and older will enjoy a YMCA Fun Day Saturday, April 16, traveling to Forest Lawn, picnicking in Griffith Park, and climaxing the day by attending a new Smell-o-vision movie in Hollywood.
All events are open to any child.
