With the return to standard time and longer hours of darkness, motorists should check their safety lighting, the Automobile Club of Southern California urged today. Barthelemy, Consul General

"As more and more driving is done during the hours of darkness, motorists should become more conscious of the dangers created by inadequate lights," said Robert J. Cheney, Auto Club Public Safety department manager.

"Headlights improperly aimed, burned-out tail lights, turn signal indicators not working and stop lights not functioning are dangerous and should be corrected," he pointed out.

Cheney also reminded motorists that driving with parking lights only is illegal and unsafe. "When it is dark enough for lights, full headlights are needed," he advised.
