TEMPLE FANS TO SEE MARK TWAIN'S 'TOM AND HUCK' TONIGHT

Duryea, Blair, Coogan, Ladd Star in Classic Colorcast

"Tom and Huck," based on three of Mark Twain's most celebrated novels—"The Adventures of Tom Sawyer," "Huckleberry Finn," and "On the River" will be seen tonight at 7 p.m. on the Channel 4 colorcast of the "Shirley Temple Show."

The teleplay by Bruce Geller is directed by Paul Nickell and features an all-star cast including Dan Duryea as Muff Potter, Janet Blair as Aunt Polly, David Ladd as Tom Sawyer and Teddy Rooney as Huck Finn. Shirley Temple stars as hostess.

Jackie Coogan, one of the great child actors of movie history, is featured as Marshal Rogers. Coogan played the part of Tom Sawyer in an early "talkie" version of "The Adventures of Tom Sawyer," and its sequel, "Huckleberry Finn," in 1929 and 1930.

Also featured in important roles are Ruthie Robinson as Becky Thatcher, Paul Stevens as Injun Joe, Lee Richardson as Doc Robinson, Ray Teal as Judge Thatcher and Felix Nelson as Jim.

In the story, the arrival of two passengers at Hannibal, Mo. from New Orleans disturbs the townsfolk in different ways. When Becky Thatcher walks down the gangplank, Tom Sawyer's heart is lost; but when Muff Potter, a former riverboat captain and alcoholic, steps off the boat, only a few are glad to see him. The rest distrust him. Injun Joe lures Muff from the dock with an unlawful scheme to make money by digging up bodies for Doc Robinson's research. To Sawyer and Huck Finn visit the graveyard because of a superstition that a dead cat will remove warts—Huck has warts. The terrified boys see the ghouls—and also witness an unscheduled murder. Because the boys have seen the murderer—and know they both will be killed if they tell—they take an oath in blood to remain silent. Later, in a hastily called session of town court, Aunt Polly convinces Tom he should tell the truth. In the end both justice—and romance—triumph.


