Mexican Student Swaps Language Lessons with Crenshaw Pupils

A reciprocal agreement with other fifth grade students at Crenshaw Elementary School is enabling a 12-year-old boy to learn to speak English. In return for their efforts he is teaching them to speak Spanish. Tony Hernandez, who is staying with the Rev. Ishmael Garcia, 3329 W. 188th St., and his family, is attending Crenshaw School for the first time this year. He previously attended schools in his native Mexico. Since Tony knew no English, this presented a problem at first. However, this was overcome quickly as one of

his fifth grade classmates, Sue Lucero, spoke both Spanish and English fluently. In addition, a first grade teacher, Dorothy Aycock, also speaks Spanish. She arranged for Tony to meet with some of her first graders as an extra activity. This way, the first graders help Tony learn English while he teaches them Spanish. She reports that both Tony and the children are enjoying this method.

In his fifth grade classroom, Teacher Robert Cardwell reports that Tony does well, and catches on quickly. With a month of school already past, Tony can understand most class discussions. Sometimes, Sue has to translate some of the unfamiliar words.

"He does very well," said Cardwell. "The fact that he comes from another country gives him a chance to teach the other youngsters something new. They are learning from each other."


