**Million Dollar Checks Given at Grand Opening**

Money flowed like water at Monday's opening Wetherby Kayser's new store in Del Amo Center, when the store presented a billion dollars in million dollar checks to each of a thousand visitors.

It was the biggest giveaway in merchandising history, comparing only with governmental foreign aid, but much less expensive.

The 'cashiers checks' each in the amount of \$1,000,000, were signed by Marvin Miller, star of television's 'The Millionaire.'

Miller was scheduled to be on hand for the Wetherby Kayser opening, but a last minute change in the shooting schedule for his latest motion picture demanded his presence in Puerto Rico.

However, Miller personally signed all of the checks prior to his departure and promised he would make the appearance early next month with another batch of million dollar checks.
