## City Sets Starting Date for New Rubbish Collection Scheduling

Notices will be sent to all commercial, industrial and multi-unit customers that the City of Torrance will discontinue collection of their refuse on February 28, it was reported Tuesday evening by city councilmen.

In a summary of the City's plans for the collection of combined rubbish from single family and two family residences, they reported that they planned to make the starting date for such collections March 1.

Notice will also be sent to all residential and two family units that the combined pick-up will be started March 1 and that on this date the garbage should be wrapped and placed in the same container as other refuse.

Councilmen did not feel that it would be economically feasible to make a separate collection of tin cans and metal for the purpose of selling them at a profit.

Plans call for the disposal of combined refuse, which

contains garbage, at a private dump and to continue the disposal of other refuse in the city dump.

Noting that the city would eliminate 1600 units from the collection routes, councilmen expressed doubts as to the need of three new packer trucks requested by the maintenance department.

Thirty-two precincts will be used in the April 18 election for members of the Torrance Board of Education, local trustees learned Tuesday night.

The same precincts will be used by the Torrance Unified School District to elect board members and by El Camino Junior College for selection of its trustees. Costs of the election will be shared by the two school districts.

Precincts will be located at all 30 Torrance elementary schools and at El Retiro Park and the Home Savings and Loan Co. building.

Cost of holding the election is about \$3500, the board was told again.
