

LEGAL NOTICES

IN THE MATTER OF COUNTY IMPROVEMENT NO. 2135 OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF 2174 STREET AND OTHER RIGHTS OF WAY

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors hereby invites sealed proposals or bids for the construction of sanitary sewers in County Improvement No. 2135, 2174 STREET and other rights of way in accordance with the terms and provisions of the Resolution of Intention adopted by the Board on the 15th day of November, 1960, and the plans and specifications therefor which are filed in the aforementioned office of said Board.

Proposals must be submitted on the blank forms prepared and furnished for the purpose and which may be obtained at the Office of the County Engineer, Room 109, of the Los Angeles County Engineering Building. At said office bidders may also obtain copies of the plans, profiles and specifications for the contemplated improvement upon deposit of \$5.00 per set, such deposit will be refunded in accordance with the terms of the aforementioned specifications.

Each submitted proposal must be accompanied by a check certified by a responsible bank, or by a bond, payable to the County of Los Angeles, in a sum equivalent to at least 10% per cent of the total aggregate amount of the bid, as a guarantee that the bidder, if his proposal be accepted, will enter into and execute the awarded contract, and furnish the required bonds in connection therewith, in accordance with the terms of the aforementioned specifications.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Labor Code of the State of California, the Board of Supervisors has ascertained the prevailing rate of per diem wages in dollars, based on a working day of eight hours, for each craft or type of workman or mechanic needed to execute the proposed contract under these specifications; and it will be required that not less than said rates be paid to all such workmen or mechanics employed or engaged upon the work.

The Contractor shall, as a penalty to the State or political subdivision on whose behalf the contract is made or awarded, forfeit ten dollars for each calendar day, or portion thereof, for each workman paid less than the stipulated prevailing rates for any public work done under the contract by him or by any subcontractor under him, and the body awarding the contract shall cause to be inserted in the contract a stipulation to this effect.

Provided that overtime rates, rate of pay for Saturdays, Sundays and holidays shall apply to those holidays as recognized in the collective bargaining agreements applicable to the particular craft, classification or type of workman employed on the project.

APPRENTICES—May be employed in conformity with Section 1777.5 of the California Labor Code.

RIGGERS—Same wage scale as craft to which rigging is incidental. WELDERS—Same wage scale as craft to which welding is incidental. FOREMEN—All foremen not herein separately classified shall be paid not less than 25 cents per hour more than the hourly equivalent of the daily rate of the highest classification in which he has supervision in the six Basic Trades.
