

HJ College Seeks Reading Assistants

Qualified applicants who are interested in employment as readers of student papers in English composition are urged to apply for the work as soon as possible, Dwight L. Garner, chairman of the Division of Humanities, said today.

The salary offered is \$2 an hour, and the rank assigned to the position is that of professional expert, or reading assistant, with the Los Angeles City Board of Education.

Requirements for the work, as specified by Board rules, include a B.A. degree and a strong background in English composition, Garner said.

The Harbor College reading assistant program is part of an experimental pilot project involving eight city high schools and seven junior colleges. Initiated in 1959, it will continue at least through June of this year, when the entire project will be re-evaluated in terms of student improvement in composition through increased practice.

"The purpose of this project is not to lighten the current load of English instructors, but to increase and improve students' writing output through more frequent assignments receiving careful marking and analysis," Garner explained.

"Applicants should phone for appointments with me or with Dean of Instruction John A. Grasham this month if possible, although later application will continue to be accepted."

Growing Trend Toward Health Insurance Shown

There is a growing trend in the health insurance business toward providing coverage for out-of-hospital diagnostic X-ray and laboratory work, the Health Insurance Institute reported today.

As of the end of 1959, at least 32 million persons were protected by insurance companies against the cost of out-of-hospital diagnostic work as a result of growing public acceptance of policies developed by the insurance industry, said the HII.

Seventy-eight insurance companies in the group field reported at the 1959 that they had covered some 10 million persons with special riders on hospital policies providing benefits for diagnostic X-ray and laboratory work done outside the hospital. The HII said there were more than 400 insurance companies in the group field.

In addition, the 22 million persons with major medical expense insurance at the end of 1959 all were covered for out-of-hospital diagnostic work, said the Institute.

There has been a rapid growth in both regular medical and major medical insurance, the HII said. In 1950, insurance companies covered eight million persons with regular medical insurance and about 100,000 with major medical insurance. The insurance company coverage figures today are estimated to be 40 million persons with regular medical insurance and 25 million persons with major medical insurance.

Air Conditioning Lease Plan Offered

An air conditioning lease plan is now available for commercial and industrial buildings that includes not only the air conditioner itself but also equipment that becomes an integral part of the building such as piping and ductwork.

The plan, which is the first air conditioning lease program to offer internal ductwork and piping, was by the Southern California Gas Company and is available in territories by the two utilities.

It was worked out by the gas company together with Arkla Air Conditioning Corp., manufacturers of the equipment, and Dow Industries, who will finance the operation and act as lessors.

This all-inclusive lease will make gas air conditioning readily available to commercial and industrial buildings all over Southern California, according to gas company vice president F. M. Foster. He pointed out that the Dow program, which has the effect of 100% financing, will allow building owners to conserve working capital and still be able to install gas air conditioning immediately.




