International Film Series Scheduled

An International film series which reached sell-out proportions when shown at UCLA and in Orange County will be presented in the South Bay area by University of California Extension this spring. They will be shown at the Plaza Theatre, 201 Plaza Square in Hawthorne.
Entitled "The Works of Great Directors," the films are considered masterpieces of motion picture art, from the early Chaplin comedies of the 1920's to very recent works. Nations represented will include the United States, France, Japan, England, Italy, Canada and the USSR.

FILM DATES
Titles of the productions and their dates are as follows:
March 2, "The Cranes are Flying," a film from Russia directed by Mikhail Kalatozov. A remarkable example of the post-Stalinist cultural

"thaw," in the USSR, the story of a young couple caught in the tragic events of World War II is told with vigor and compassion.

March 23, "The Gold Rush," written, directed, produced and acted by Charles Chaplin, he has even composed the music scores for the film. Produced in 1925, it was selected for showing at the 1958 Brussels World's Fair as "One of the Five Greatest Films of All Time."

April 13, "A Man Escaped," directed by Robert Bresson of France. An exceptional use of sound and expert direction of an entirely non-professional cast helped Bresson capture the best director award in the 1957 Cannes Film Festival for this film.

May 4, "Good Morning (Ohayo)" directed by Yasujiro Ozu of Japan. This is the forty-ninth film of Yasujiro Ozu, an undisputed master of the screen who has yet remained entirely unknown to the American film-goer. A comedy with the special brand of delicate Japanese humor.

May 25, "The Nights of Cabiria," directed by Federico Fellini of Italy. Fellini uses the unlikely medium of a little, stray street-walker to show the indestructibility of the human spirit in the most degrading circumstances. Awarded the International Catholic Film Award in 1957, the Saturday Review pronounced the film a "subtle interplay of technique and emotion which we call art."

Tickets for the series may be purchased from the Concert Ticket Office of University of California Extension, Los Angeles 24 (GRanite 8-7578). The charge is \$4 for the series.
