Opinions of Teachers Important, Says Hanson

In a talk before a group of West Torrance parents, Bill Hanson, candidate for the Torrance Board of Education stated that the classroom teachers are the heart of our school system, and that more attention should be paid to their opinions, abilities and needs.

Since the Teacher is closest to the student, said Hanson, she is in the best position to evaluate the effect of the educational program, and ought to have a stronger voice in revising and improving the curriculum, selecting textbooks, and adopting new educational techniques and materials. He believes that constructive criticism of school policies by the teacher should be welcomed by the administration and the school board.

at the expense of the rest of the class. In addition, the administrators should support the teachers in a strict policy to prevent cheating, he said. A lax attitude toward this evil can corrupt our youth by giving them the feeling that "everybody does it".

ENCOURAGED

Teachers at all grade levels should be encouraged to increase their knowledge and understanding of subject matter, as well as to improve their teaching methods, he said, and incentives should be provided for them to do so. High school teachers can increase their competence in their major or minor fields, and should be given teaching assignments only in these fields.
