

Torrance Civic Leader Speaks on TV

'Teach Our Children About U.S.' Theme Of Gloria Stadler

"Teach Our Children About America—By Example" will be the theme of Torrance Civic leader Gloria Stadler tomorrow night on Baxter Ward's "Comment" over KCOP, Channel 13, at 9 p.m.

Mrs. Stadler, prominent PTA head in Torrance, taped her speech Tuesday night at the Hollywood facility for airing Monday night. Ward and the station, in recent weeks, have invited leaders of communities throughout Los Angeles County to present their views to a growing number of listeners.

The Torrance dignitary will say in part: "Because I want my five children to be able to define what America stands for I began looking for some way in which I could set the example . . . the only positive approach to combating Communism, I feel, should be to learn what we believe in as well as what our nation believes in . . . the rest is up to the FBI."

Mrs. Stadler will also, in her three minute speech, tell how parents can learn more about the mechanics of their city's school board, and what they should realize of a candidate running for election to that body. The KCOP speaker will inform the general public what political costs are involved in getting elected to the board.

In closing, Mrs. Stadler believes that "we must be the

ones, parents, to take our children to church or to the synagogue . . . not send them . . . and most of all we must be able to answer the question . . . "What does America Stand For?"
