Kidd, Beatty Head List At MSA Relays on Friday

Bruce Kidd, Canada's phenomenal 17-year old distance runner will go in the 5000 meters and Jim Beatty makes an assault on his American mile record of 3:58.0 against Laszlo Tabori and Jim Grelle at the third annual Mt. San Antonio Relays April 28-29.

Relays Director Hilmer Lodge made the double announcement today and disclosed that the field for the two-day, 127-event carnival has already hit 1613 athletes including high school, junior college, college and university-open entries.

Kidd, greatest runner of all time for his age, won the National AAU indoor 3-mile championship in 13:47.0, and ran the 2-mile on the boards in 8:49.1 to set the track tongues wagging.

Best available distance runners go against the Canadian youngster including Charley Clark, 8:55 2-miler of San Jose State. Irish star Tom O'Riordan of Idaho State, Merle McGee, Santa Clara VVY and others.

TURN DOWN BIDS
Fred Foot, Kidd's coach at the Toronto Track Club, said he turned down many bids including the Penn Relays

for an opportunity to run on Mt. San Antonio's wonder track and a crack at Beatty's U.S. Record of 13:51.7, best ever 5000 on this continent.

Coach Hihaly Igloi, who turned Beatty into the champ he is, said teammate Tabori of the Santa Clara VVY will be in the mile for tactical purposes. When the two ran together in 1960 Beatty set his mile and 5000 marks. Grelle ran 4:00; outdoors in '60 and was No. 1 American on the board in 1961 at 4:03.6.

In addition to Kidd, Foot of Toronto is bringing Bill brothers, No. 1 indoor 500 runner at 57.3 for the open 440; and halfmiler Stan Worsford to go against Ernie Cunliffe in Ernie's avowed plans of breaking Tom Courtney's world 880 record of 1:46.8.

Tickets for the Relays including Friday afternoon and evening and Saturday afternoon and evening priced at \$2.50 are on sale throughout Southern California, or by writing to Mt. San Antonio College, College Station, Walnut, Calif.

University-open events are Saturday afternoon.
