

Neptune Days Cancelled This Year in Redondo Beach, Says Ken Boyd, Chamber Prexy

Neptune Days will not be held this year in Redondo Beach, Chamber President, Ken Boyd announced today.

Boyd said construction of Redondo Beach King Harbor and the resulting traffic and parking problems make it most impractical to offer a complete summer celebration in 1961.

The usual July 4th fireworks display will take place, however, Chamber officials added. To raise the necessary \$1500 for the fireworks the Chamber will sponsor a small carnival in the parking lot bounded by Pacific, North Catalina Streets, subject to City approval.

Community organizations will be offered game and food booths free of charge, Chairman Clyde Moor said. The participating groups may keep any proceeds, Moor added. Interested groups were urged to declare intention of participation by calling the Chamber office.

Past President, Stan Vaughan, who will assist Moor in the project, said the Carnival would not be allowed to have any game booths and the only food concession operated by them would be the traditional wagon.




