

EVAPORATED MILK

44 TB Cases Reported in May By LA County

Forty-four new cases of tuberculosis were reported in Los Angeles County during the week ending May 27, bringing to 1,022 the number of newly reported TB cases thus far in 1961.

Leland A. Phillips, president of the Tuberculosis and Health Association of Los Angeles County, said that although the number of new TB cases remains high, county health department figures a reduction this year over the last. A total of 1,081 new TB cases were reported for the comparable period in 1960, he said.


