

"Memory of Murder," Circle Theater Presentation Wednesday, July 19

The sixteen-year-old murder of a Florida sheriff that was solved by his determined and courageous son is the subject of "The Memory of Murder," which will be repeated on Armstrong Circle Theater Wednesday, July 19, from 10-11 PM over Channel 2.
