



**Nursing League to Organize, Break From County Group**

Harbor area nurses, allied professional groups and interested citizens will, effective Jan. 1, activate their own unit of the California League for Nursing, it was announced today.

They presently are members of Unit "E" of the league, which comprises all of Los Angeles County.

The new organization will be named Unit "H" and will have its own constitution and by-laws.

Mary Patterson, chairman of the group, announced that the board of directors of the California League for Nursing has approved petitions for Unit "H" status and the date and place of the first meeting will be announced later.

"We wish to make it clear that this action dividing Unit "E" is an amicable one," Mrs. Patterson added, "the feeling is that nursing and allied groups in the Harbor area have problems unique to this area and that their solution will be more easily effected by formation of this unit."

Similar units from all of the state comprise the California League for Nursing, which in turn is a member of the National League for Nursing, organized in 1952.

The national has 24,000 members and more than 1200 participating groups. "The objective of the league down through its state and locals is to foster the development of nursing services and education through the coordinated action of nurses, allied professional groups and interested citizens to the end that the nursing needs of people will be met," Mrs. Patterson said.


