2 Jobs Open; City Exams Set Feb. 23

Examinations will be held Feb. 23 for two positions with the City of Torrance, and final filing date for the examinations is Feb. 13.

One position is equipment mechanic with a starting salary of \$563 per month. The other is senior engineering aide, at \$578 per month.

The equipment mechanic will tune-up, service and make major mechanical repairs to autos, trucks, and other city equipment. The engineering aide will perform office engineering work.

Qualifications for equipment mechanic are an eighth grade education and three years experience in mechanical repair work. The senior engineering aide must have two years experience in drafting or surveying work. College work in civil engineering may be substituted on a year-for-year basis.

Bruinsma Urges GOP Volunteer Group To 'Save 2-Party System in California'

A "Federation of Republican Volunteers" has been proposed by Theodore A. (Ted) Bruinsma, last November's GOP candidate for Congressman in the 17th District.

Bruinsma said the federation is needed "to save the two-party system in California."

The proposal was made during an address to the Palos Verdes Peninsula Men's Republican Club in Waverly.

During the talk, Bruinsma outlined a program for restoring Republican strength in Los Angeles County.

One of the points was "better use of Republican volunteers, through the expanded creation of grass roots clubs in every community."

Bruinsma, looking back on last November's election, said that the GOP failed in three areas: registration, finance, and getting out the vote.

Kuchel Picks South Hi Boy

Philip Q. Dowsing, 626 Calle Arboles, who attends South High School, is one of 11 boys chosen by Sen. Thomas H. Kuchel, Republican, to fill a vacancy at the U.S. Air Force Academy at Colorado Springs, Colo.

Sen. Kuchel said the final selections will be made by admitting officers at the academy from those who made top scores in the U.S. Civil Service examinations.

Harvey Aluminum aids school as good citizen

As a corporate citizen in the community, Harvey Aluminum has a responsibility to participate in the betterment of education.

"All of these are tasks where a better use of the available volunteers could have achieved improved results," said Bruinsma.

He proposed to work with presently existing groups that are effective. For example, Bruinsma mentioned the Federated Women's Clubs.

"However," he added, "they do not cover all areas and in many communities there are no counterparts for the men volunteers."

Bruinsma emphasized that the proposed Federation of Volunteers must be organized within the framework of the Republican Party.

"The party," he said, "is not merely the elected officials and their designees. It is each and every registered Republican."

Bruinsma proposed that the Federation of Volunteers should proceed on an eight-year plan, which involves both long and short-range goals.

"If there is a meaningful program of action," he added, "there will be no need for speeches about unity by fewer and fewer leaders to smaller and smaller audiences."

Unity, he said, under such a Federation of Volunteers program, will be a reality and "we will have greater numbers of Republicans doing the essential between-elections-work that makes victory possible."

Elaborating on the long and short-range goals, Bruinsma suggested the following:

Long-range goal: Election of the necessary GOP Assemblymen by 1970 to

"restore a fair and equitable districting."

Short-range goals: Carrying Los Angeles County for a GOP Senator in 1964; a Republican Governor in 1966; recapturing Congressional seats in every district where Republicans have at least 40 percent registration.

L.A. Nudges State on Smog Device

The Los Angeles smog control authorities are jogging the state to act on approving an automobile anti-smog system developed by Chrysler Corporation.

Smith Griswold, Los Angeles air pollution control officer, called the Chrysler development "an economical and effective means of controlling smog-forming emissions from automobiles."

Chrysler, according to Griswold, is ready to market new cars with the new system, providing the California authorities approve it.

Los Angeles tests, said Griswold, as well as tests by independent laboratories, confirm the conclusions that the kits will "do the job."

"There is no real reason why the state should delay any longer in determining whether the Chrysler modifications would be helpful in reducing smog and, if they are, in putting them into use," said Griswold.

The Chrysler development is described by Griswold as "a system of engine modifications which reduce hydrocarbons and carbon monoxide."

Crissman vs. Safford

National champion Jack Crissman of Long Beach will meet adversary Ken Safford of Hollywood in the fuel eliminator contest Sunday afternoon at Lions Drag Strip in Long Beach.

Just two weeks ago, Crissman took the No. 8 spot on the national fuel dragster ratings away from the highly rated Crissman.

Crissman will also compete for the gas eliminator title coming up against John Peters of Santa Monica.
